BRIAN FUDGE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Brian Fudge, the son of Derek Fudge and Jill Broadbent, and brother of Steve, graduated from John McRae High School in Ottawa in June 2001 and from the Police Foundations program at Humber College in Toronto in May 2004. On January 2, 2005 Brian passed away after having just celebrated his 22nd birthday.

CRITERIA:

Winner will be determined on the basis of a 750 to 1,000 word essay on:

The importance of their field of study in either policing, criminal justice services or health care in delivering public services to Canadians.

An application form must be completed and accompany the essay.

ELIGIBILITY:

All those entering a field of study in policing, criminal justice services, community services or health care services and who are children/ grandchildren (including foster children/ grandchildren) of National Union of Public and General Employees' current/retired members who plan to enter the 1st year of a Canadian public, post-secondary institution full-time in 2018 / 2019 are eligible to apply.

AWARD:

The amount of the scholarship is \$1,500. Information provided by the winner will be verified prior to the awarding of the scholarship.
