BRIAN FUDGE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Brian Fudge, the son of Derek Fudge and Jill Broadbent, and brother of Steve, graduated from John McRae High School in Ottawa in June 2001 and from the Police Foundations program at Humber College in Toronto in May 2004. On January 2, 2005 Brian passed away after just having celebrated his 22nd birthday.

CRITERIA:

Winner will be determined on the basis of a 750 to 1,000 word essay on:

The importance of your field of study in either policing, criminal justice, community services or health care in delivering public services to Canadians.

An application form must be completed and accompany the essay.

Marks are allocated for presentation.

ELIGIBILITY:

All those entering a field of study in policing, criminal justice, community services or health care and who are children/grandchildren (including foster children/grandchildren) of National Union of Public and General Employees' current/retired members and who are planning to enter the 1st year of a Canadian **public**, post-secondary education institution full-time in 2019/2020 are eligible to apply.

AWARD:

The amount of the scholarship is \$1,500.
