At the Bargaining Table

RATIFICATION REVIEW

On August 28, members of **Family Dynamics - Local 212**, who provide coordinated, community-based supports for Winnipeg families, ratified a two-year agreement which includes improvements to leave and the addition of wellness days.

NEGOTIATIONS CONTINUE ON BEHALF OF HUNDREDS OF MEMBERS THIS FALL

Over a dozen MGEU Locals, many from the Community-Based Social Services Component, bargained through the summer and will continue into fall.

For instance, the Bargaining Committee for over 400 **Government Community Workers (Locals 251-256, 258)**, who provide home-based family supports throughout the province, will return to the table in September, and **Michif Child and Family Services**, with Locals in The Pas, Dauphin and Brandon, will resume negotiations in November.

In the Public Eye

SURVEY SAYS? MANITOBANS DISAGREE WITH CUTS!

On Monday, August 28, I spoke with the **Winnipeg Free Press** about a recent Probe Research poll commissioned by the MGEU that revealed **a majority of Manitoba adults (71%) feel the government's health care reforms are going too far, too fast**. An overwhelming majority of Manitobans (86%) also said the government should release the KPMG report that has guided the government's health care changes.

PRIVATE MRIs WILL TAKE US IN A DANGEROUS DIRECTION

I also wrote an Opinion piece that appeared in the paper the next day, arguing that the **private MRI clinic** being proposed by the town of Niverville will NOT fix our diagnostic wait time problem — it will sell out Medicare for the benefit of a small group of profit-driven private investors. The quality of your health care should no be determined by the size of your wallet!

Meanwhile, after eight months at the table, the **Emergency Medical Services (EMS), Superintendents - Local 431** Bargaining Committee is scheduled to resume bargaining on September 18, this time with the aid of a conciliator.

SCHOOL'S IN, LET THE BARGAINING BEGIN

The Bargaining Committees for over 2,000 members in **Assiniboine Community College/Red River College Central Table - Locals 71/73 and Seine River School Division - Local 134-135** are set to exchange bargaining proposals with the employer this fall.

PREP FOR HCSS NEGOTIATIONS CONTINUES DESPITE LIKELY BARGAINING UNIT VOTE

The government has yet to reveal when their proposed legislation to reduce the number of health care bargaining units will be proclaimed.

In the meantime, the Health Care Support Services Central Table Bargaining Committee is finalizing its proposal package and moving forward to commence negotiations.

FAILING TO PROTECT ALL FRONT LINE STAFF, PROGRAMS PUTS PATIENTS AT RISK

We held a news conference on August 15 to let Manitobans know



the government has not yet lived up to its earlier commitment that there will be jobs for all front line staff in the WRHA. With MGEU members at Victoria Hospital facing lay-offs, this is deeply concerning and we continue to work with Local representatives to determine next steps.
